  - 3.4 Subject + linking verb (v to be) + prepositional phrase I am in a classroom.

## Auxiliary (Helping) verb

- 1 Primary auxiliary
  - I verb to be + present participle (ving)
  - (1.2 verb to do + base form verb
  - 1.3 verb to have + past participle (v3)
  - **2 Modal auxiliary** (will, would, shall, should, may, might, can, could, ought to, must, need, dare, used to)

Can + base form



# SENTENCE COMPONENTS

## Subject

- The subject can be :
- 1 noun/noun phrase/noun clause
- 2 Pronoun
- 3 Infinitive/Infinitive phrase
- 4 Gerund/ Gerund phrase

## Subject

- 1 Simple subject (one word)
  - a common noun (Boys, Girls, Teachers, Parents)
  - a proper noun (Fatimoh, Alice, Davika)
  - a personal pronoun (I, You, We, They, He, She, It)
  - an indefinite pronoun (Someone, Something, Nobody)
- 2 Phrase (group of words)
  - noun phrase This American President..., A poor boy
  - infinitive phrase To live in a cave alone ..., To work hard...
  - gerund phrase Collecting stamps..., Planting trees...
- 3 Compound subject (two subjects are combined by coordinating conjunctions and correlative conjunction)
- -A man and a woman..., Not only the man but also his wife...
- Both swimming and jogging... -Neither love nor hatred ...
