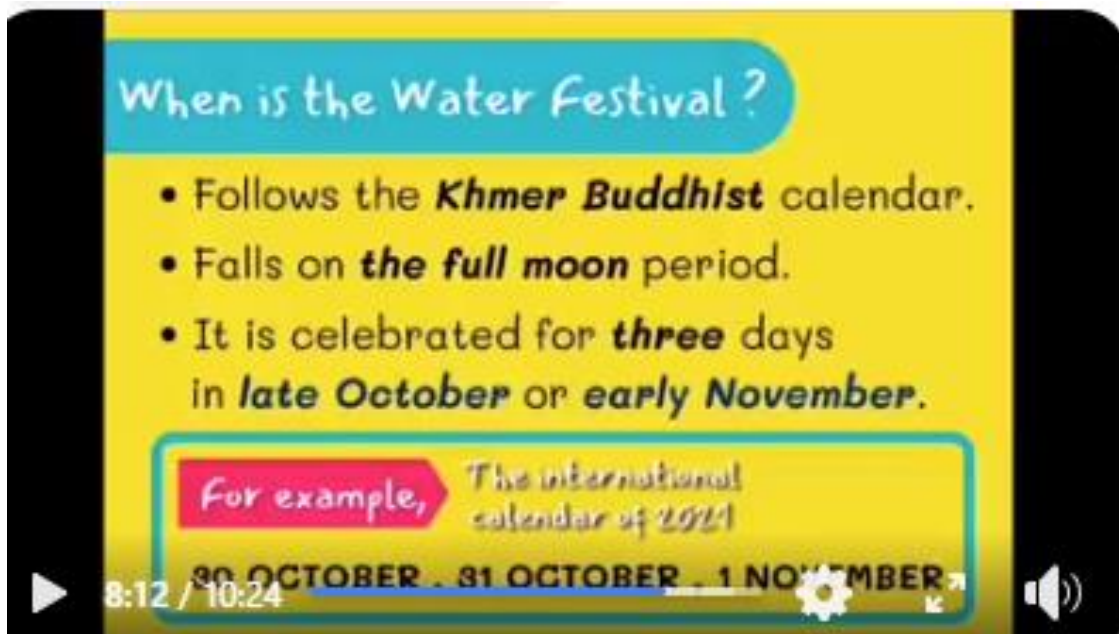

 - In front of Royal Palace in Phnom Penh
 - The final round will be held on the last day ,afternoon.
- The festival's *Khmer* name
 - 'Bon Om Tuk,' = 'Boat Racing Festival'

- Buddhist families in Cambodia eat Auk Ambok after midnight when revelers gather at the temples to celebrate the harvest moon.
