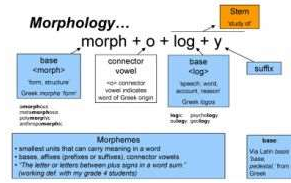

Non-morphemic word-formation process



2. Conversion: N>V

| <p>A. He has been in jail for three months.</p> <p>B. They should jail him for life.</p> | Transfer meaning |
| <p>A. He had only a slice of bread for breakfast.</p> <p>B. He sliced the bread.</p> | Effective meaning |
| <p>A. She used a lot of pins to fasten pieces of cloth together.</p> <p>B. She pinned te badge onto her jacket.</p> | Instrumental meaning |

2. Conversion: Adj>V

|--|--------------------|
| <p>A. The wood was dry.</p> <p>B. The sheets dried in the sun.</p> | Inchoative meaning |
| <p>A. She has dark brown hair.</p> <p>B. She browned the meat in a frying pan.</p> | Causative meaning |

2. Conversion: V>N

- | | |
|---|---------------|
| <p>A. He delayed his decision on whether to warn the public.</p> <p>B. There was a delay in warning the public.</p> | event/ action |
| <p>A. She fell off her bike and bruised her knee.</p> <p>B. She got a bruise on her knee.</p> | result |

2. Conversion: Adj>N

rich	>	the rich
blind	>	the blind
poor	>	the poor
tough	>	the tough
smart	>	the smart

- A. They are **rich** people.
- B. Those houses belong to **the rich**.

3. Backformation

orate	<	orator
sculpt	<	sculptor
donate	<	donation
orient	<	orientation
televise	<	television

- A. Gas prices are expected to continue to **escalate** in the short term.
- B. They **escalated** down to the lower level.
